Superscript note explanations:

- Legal Research & Writing (OCT) begins 10/10/16-ends 12/12/16; Introduction to Law (OCT) begins 10/11/6/16 - ends 12/13/16.
- Law Study & Exams - starts 9/29/16 and ends 12/8/16, then restarts 1/5/17 and ends 2/2/17.
- Legal Aid Clinic - option to take for 2 or 3 units
- Moot Court limited to 16 students, priority given to 3rd- and 4th-year students.
- Disability Law Clinic is limited to 6 students. (Option to take for 1 or 2 units also.)
- SHAC is limited to 8 students. (First three training class sessions meet 6:00 – 9:00 P.M.)
- Immigration Law Clinic is limited to 15 students.
