Superscript note explanations:

- 1 Legal Research & Writing (OCT) begins 10/2/17-ends 12/4/17; Introduction to Law (OCT) begins 10/3/17 - ends 12/5/17.
- 2 Law Study & Exams - starts 9/28/17 and ends 12/7/17, then restarts 1/4/18 and ends 2/1/18.
- 3 Legal Aid Clinic - option to take for 2 or 3 units
- 4 Moot Court limited to 16 students, priority given to 3rd- and 4th-year students.
- 5 Disability Law Clinic is limited to 6 students. (Option to take for 1 or 2 units also.)
